2025 Pre-App Civic and Community Center Financing Fund (CCCFF)

Description

The Civic and Community Center Financing Fund (CCCFF) grants are awarded and administered by the Nebraska Department of Economic Development (DED) to encourage and foster quality of life in our communities. Nebraska municipalities, including rural cities and villages, and tribal governments may apply for CCCFF grants.

These grants are awarded on a competitive basis to construct and/or improve community facilities such as libraries, recreation and wellness centers, gathering spaces, convention centers, town squares, and cultural centers. Projects may include the conversion, rehabilitation, or reuse of historic buildings. The program may also be used for preliminary planning related to the development or rehabilitation of eligible projects.

The cash match requirement is at least 1:1.

Refer to Application Program Guidelines for Grant Award Floor and Award Ceiling. Amounts available depend on the type of applicant and type of grant.

2025 Cycle, Municipalities: Grants of less than \$3,000 will not be eligible for award.
